3 I, Leilei Shao, request a restraining order against my husband Ian Hipp, Respondent.
4 Respondent and I have been married for seven years. We separated on September 3, 2021. We
5 currently still live together. We have one child from this relationship, Luna, who is turning two
6 on September 26, 2021. Respondent frequently yells at me and insults me, calling me stupid,
7 retarded, lazy, and ugly, and he has been physically violent with me on three separate occasions.
8 Most recently, on September 3, 2021, Respondent was holding our daughter Luna and started
9 verbally abusing me during an argument. He grabbed me by the arm and tried to throw me out
10 of the room, leaving scratches and bruises. I grabbed our daughter from him and took her to the
11 neighbor's house, where I called the police. The police came and arrested Respondent. I am
12 requesting a Mandarin language interpreter for my restraining order hearing.

14 **MOVE-OUT ORDER:** I am requesting that Respondent be removed from our home.
15 Respondent and I rent the home and have been living there for almost four years. I am scared
16 that if Respondent is not removed from our home, his abuse and violence will continue. It is not
17 in our daughter's best interests to witness or experience domestic abuse.

19 **FIREARMS:** To my knowledge, Respondent does not own or have access to any firearms.

21 **RECENT ABUSE:** On September 3, 2021, I told Respondent I was going to move to the
22 smaller bedroom in our house because I did not want to share a bedroom with him anymore. I
23 went in there to start moving his things to make room for mine, and he came into the room telling
24 me not to touch his stuff. He began hurling insults at me while holding our daughter in his arms.
25 He told me: "Your brain must be the size of a squirrel's, because you're so stupid." Our daughter
26 said "mama" and Respondent then started talking to my daughter: "Yes, mama. She wants a
27 brain but she just doesn't have one." He continued verbally abusing me, calling me a "fucking
28 retard," "stupid shit," and "stupid slut." At one point I told him to stop yelling next to our

1 daughter's ears and he said: "Yeah, that's the only way I get through to your pig-ass ears—your
2 stupid, fucking pig-ass ears." He also said to me: "You don't have a husband that loves you.
3 Why? Because you don't deserve it." He grabbed my arm twice during the fight and was yelling
4 at me and trying to throw me out of the room. He left scratches and bruises on my arms.
5 Eventually I was able to grab our daughter from his arms, and I took her to our neighbor's house
6 and called the police. The police came, took pictures of my arms, and wrote a report. That case
7 number is #21041707. They arrested Respondent and took him to jail.

8 When Respondent was released from jail and came back to the house on Monday to get
9 some of his belongings, the way he looked at me scared me. He looked at me like he was full of
10 hate and wanted to hurt me. I think he blames me for him going to jail, and I am scared of what
11 he will do next without a restraining order in place.

12

13 **HISTORY OF ABUSE:** Respondent has a history of having a bad temper. He also told me
14 bad things happened while he was in the Navy. He has anger issues but refuses to see a therapist
15 and believes he is always right. His anger used to be directed at other people, but during the past
16 year, he has turned his anger towards me. We began fighting frequently, and our relationship
17 has deteriorated.

18 The September 3, 2021 incident was the third time Respondent has been physically
19 violent with me. The first time he was physically violent was on or around September 26, 2020.
20 We got into an argument on our daughter's first birthday because his brother did not follow our
21 house rules related to the Covid-19 pandemic, which we had to try to keep ourselves and our
22 daughter safe. I was upset and Respondent and I began arguing. Respondent got very angry and
23 slapped me in the face, and then he left the house.

24 The second time Respondent was physically violent with me was on or around February
25 11, 2021. Our daughter was having breakfast and Respondent was in a bad mood and got angry
26 because the Amazon Alexa was not working. Our daughter started to cry, so I went to comfort
27 her. Respondent then turned his anger on me, blaming me for our daughter crying and telling
28 me that I'm a bad mom. He called me a "lazy-ass" and "fat-ass," and told me I am "stupid" and

1 "ugly." We started arguing and throughout the fight he slapped me in the face three times. I
2 wrote down the details of this incident in my diary.

3 In addition to the physical abuse, Respondent also constantly verbally abuses me and calls
4 me names, particularly when we are arguing. He often calls me "stupid" and "crazy, and he
5 blames me any time our daughter cries. One time he threw our daughter's baby high chair from
6 the dining room into the garage when he was angry.

7

8 **CHILD CUSTODY/OTHER PEOPLE TO BE PROTECTED:** I am requesting that our
9 daughter be protected in this order and that he temporarily not have visitation with her. I don't
10 want our daughter growing up in this environment. It is not healthy. She is growing older and
11 will understand more and more what is happening. As described above, he called me horrible
12 names in front of her, to her, and also got physical with me while holding her in his arms.
13 Respondent has slapped me, scratched me, and grabbed my arms and bruised me, all in front of
14 our daughter. He also screams at my in front of our daughter, which scares her and makes her
15 cry.

16

17 I need this protective order for my safety and security, because I am afraid of what
18 Respondent will do to me if I do not get a restraining order. Our daughter Luna also needs to be
19 protected.

20 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the
21 foregoing is true and correct.
